

Sustainable Catering

Thank you for partnering with us to achieve our clients' environmental priorities!

To prevent waste, reusable cutlery and plates are required for an entire crew at sit-down meals.



Caterers and Chefs:

- Provide **reusable** plates and metal utensils for entire crew at sit-down meals
- Provide **reusable** utensils as an option at breakfast (at least spoons and forks for hot foods)
- Utilize **reusable** serving bowls, platters and utensils



- Eliminate** the use of all styrofoam products and **prioritize** paper or plant-based products over plastic products (cups, utensils, stir sticks, coffee lids)
- Separate compost** on set using EcoSet's sorting bins, keeping food and wet waste out of recycling bin (see page 2)
- Avoid placing** disposable gloves in organics bin



Styrofoam products may not be used on set.

If reusable service items cannot be used:

- Purchase **paper** or wood-like disposable products
- Paper products (plates, bowls, cups and napkins) go in the Organics bin
- Use take-away containers that are paper, plant-based, or a foil wrapped paper plate

Please Choose Paper

Plant-based "compostable" plastic products are no longer being processed by most compost facilities. Paper or wood-like options are the best. Please avoid clear plastic-type cups when possible.



Paper is preferred!



Great for parfaits and soup!



Consider bamboo utensils

Plastic = Landfill

If it looks like plastic, and is smaller than the palm of your hand, it will wind up in the landfill. Please **minimize** use of these items. Clean, dry plastic cups can be recycled but please avoid them for parfaits, smoothies, and similar menu items.

Composting

If it comes from a plant or an animal, it's COMPOSTABLE.

Plant-based products are made from corn, wheat, potato, and sugar cane, and can be composted into soil at an industrial composting facility or recycled and turned into fuel through anaerobic digestion. Paper products with no plastic lining are fully compostable.

Other requests:

- Use pasta (or metal spoons) as stir sticks, avoid plastic and wooden stir sticks
- Purchase bulk items to prevent packaging waste
- Avoid seafood and fish from the Red List (Monterey Bay Seafood Watch: www.seafoodwatch.org)

Please help us by keeping latex gloves out of the organics bin.

EcoSet will provide one slim 23 gallon organics bin for your truck, and a second bin for everything else. We will sort out the recyclable items from landfill items.

Prep waste and plate scrapings can be converted into a **valuable soil product or source of fuel.**
